### NETS & UNHOOKING MATS

Do **NOT** bring these with you to the lakes. Landing Nets and Unhooking Mats are provided on site for pleasure anglers.

Match anglers will be provided with full sets on match days.

Keepnets are only allowed on organised matches.

After use, nets should be dipped and rinsed and hung in the drying cage.

Intermediate grade is a concessionary rate to help the age group who may be in Further Education or Apprenticeships. In all respects, this group has full Senior status.

Seniors are required to do at least 2 x 3.5 hour Sunday morning working parties during a specified period, to entitle them to renewal. Persons with valid reasons for exemption, **must** notify the Committee early.

Regular Outings/Society Matches are organised throughout the Season, this also includes all Juniors.

Trophies for Winners are presented at a time and date designated by the Match Secretary.

Discounts can be obtained from Watford Tackle Carrier on presentation of Society Membership Card. This does not include bait.

The Ladies Match held at the beginning of August, is not only open to Lady Members, but also to Wives, Daughters, Girl Friends, Partners etc. It is a good reason for the ladies of the family to appreciate their partners hobby and the peace and quiet surrounding the lake. After the Match there is a Bar-B-Que (weather permitting).

Any members wanting to discuss or put forward ideas, can come to a Committee Meeting on the first Thursday of each month. Discussions will take place half an hour before the meetings which start at 8.00pm.

All members are Society Bailiffs and should assist in upholding the rules.

### Privilege Tickets

Senior members wishing to bring a friend to fish Society Waters, may purchase a privilege ticket from Martin Jones at the Tackle Carrier in Watford, Alex Hyndman at the lake or Colin & Joan Bushnell opposite the lake at number 11 Railway Terrace.

This ticket will entitle the friend to honorary membership for one day only and he/she must be accompanied by the member whilst fishing. Member wives and children under 16 years old, will be deemed honorary members but may only fish when accompanied by the member. Junior members are not allowed to bring friends on to the lake complex.
